Organ Lecture Concert

The Family Program is a festival for families held mainly during the "Golden Week" holidays (from around the end of April to the first week in May) and the summer holidays. The program features many events that visitors can enjoy with their family members, so even novice theater goers can participate without hesitation. The events include not only performances but also backstage tours and workshops designed for children.

The Aichi Arts Center Festival is held during a celebration period of days including October 30, the anniversary day of the opening of Aichi Arts Center. During the festival, many performances bring out "oohs" and "aahs" even from great art connoisseurs! This festival is recommended to those who desire to enjoy high-quality arts.

The Mini Theater Selection is the name of a series of cutting-edge and experimental programs held at the Mini Theater. This is a selection of contemporary works recommended enthusiastically to people living in Aichi.

Aichi Prefecture has about 70,000 children per grade at elementary and junior high schools. With the aim of ensuring that every child will visit a theater at least once during their compulsory education period, since FY2015, Aichi Prefectural Art Theater has been implementing the "Theater and 70,000 Children" Project in collaboration with municipalities. The project aims to provide the children, as future leaders of the region, with valuable cultural and artistic experiences by inviting them to watch high-quality performing arts at the theater.
